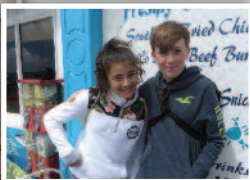

### Pre Leaving Certificate Students 3rd to 5th year

This course will benefit students who will sit the Leaving Certificate examination in 2018. Strong emphasis on the Oral Irish. We provide extra classes for 5th year students at no extra cost to cover all aspects of the curriculum.

### Pre Junior Certificate Students 1st & 2nd year

This course will benefit students who are in 1st and 2nd year. Topics on the Junior Certificate curriculum will be covered throughout on an interactive basis.

### Primary School Students

Our aim is to develop each child's potential of the Irish language to the full and to encourage a love of learning Gaeilge through interactive teaching methods. We help children develop social skills they will use all their lives.

### Accommodation

All students stay in houses which have been inspected by the Department of Arts, Heritage and Gaeltacht. Bean a Tí follows a menu which has been agreed with Coláistí Chorca Dhuibhne. Courses are filled on a first come, first served basis. It may not always be possible to provide accommodation where requested.

### Rules of the College

- Students must speak Irish at all times.
- All students must obey instructions received from the Principal, Teachers, Bean a Tí and assistants.
- All students must return to their houses from the Céilí at the appointed time and are not permitted to leave thereafter prior to 9 am on the following morning. This also applies to students taken out for the day or part of the day by Parents/Guardians.
- Possession or use of tobacco, alcoholic drink or addictive substances is prohibited. Students are not allowed to enter a licensed premises.
