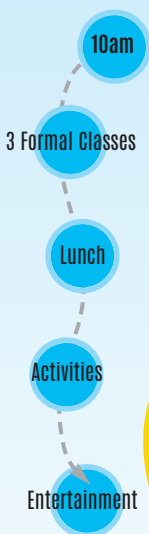

Rules of the College

- 1 Students must speak Irish at all times.
- 2 All students must follow instructions received from the Principal, Teachers, Bean a Tí and assistants.
- 3 All students must return to their houses from the Céilí at the appointed time and are not permitted to leave thereafter prior to 9 am on the following morning. This also applies to students taken out for the day or part of the day by Parents/Guardians.
- 4 Possession or use of tobacco, alcoholic drink or addictive substances is prohibited. Students are not allowed to enter a licensed premises.
- 5 Students must comply with the rules of the road. Please bring a yellow high visibility vest as walking to the Centre will be part of the course.
- 6 The use of mobile phones will be restricted to 1hour each evening. Please refer to 'Parents Information' on website for full details.
- 7 No aerosol deodorants permitted.
- 8 Only 3 friend's names will be accepted in relation to accommodation arrangements.
