- 1 Students must speak Irish at all times.
- 2 All students must follow instructions received from the Principal, Teachers. Bean a Tí and assistants.
- 3 All students must return to the college from the Céilí at the appointed time and are not permitted to leave thereafter prior to 9 am on the following morning. This also applies to students taken out for the day or part of the day by Parents/Guardians.
